CONCERT

This Charity, run by Father Peter Walters, works in Colombia with children from the streets and shanty-towns of the city of Medellin. At present the Charity is working with 550 boys and girls in this city. Their ages range from six-year-olds to teenagers and they are often unloved and unwanted; even beaten, robbed, raped and sometimes murdered. The charity aims to safeguard the lives of these children from the poverty and violence of the streets and shanty-towns and to make their lives worth living by giving them love, education and a future.
