IN REMEMBRANCE

At every Mass, we pray for our deceased relatives and friends but, in keeping with Catholic tradition, November is a month specifically dedicated to praying for the Holy Souls. On or near the Feast of All Souls, a special *Mass of Remembrance* is celebrated in our parish for all our deceased loved ones. As a Parish community, we now hope to commemorate our deceased parishioners in two very special and everlasting ways:

Firstly, we think it fitting to establish a dedicated *Altar of Remembrance* on which a *Parish Memorial Book* will be placed as a perpetual reminder of all our deceased parishioners.

Secondly, we also wish to provide families and friends of our deceased parishioners - and benefactors - the option to dedicate individual/family *Memorial Plaques* which will be permanently mounted on the walls around this Altar.

A "*Memorial Plaque*" brochure, available after Mass in the sacristy, contains more details of these plans. We hope you share our view that these plans provide a befitting memorial to our deceased loved ones and that you will support our endeavours.

CMAS—Did you know one-in-seven adults living in parishes across the Diocese of Paisley are at least three months behind with bills or feel their debts are a heavy burden? That rises to over one-in-six in Inverclyde and Renfrewshire. Community Money Advice Scotland (CMAS) is a Christian charity supporting churches to run their own advice centres tackling this problem. Local volunteers are trained to provide free face-to-face advice for anyone struggling financially with rising rents, unpaid bills or benefit sanctions. We recognise you are now considering how best to renew the Diocese's local vision through "Making All Things New", reaffirming that the Church exists to "make Christ present in our world...by the love and concern that we have for each other, and for the poor and the marginalised". We would be grateful for your help encouraging parishioners to consider becoming more involved in offering debt advice locally as part of this Gospel work. Please share this invitation with any interested parishioners for them to hear more at our "Debt in the Diocese" discussion on Saturday 16 June at St Mary's Hall in Greenock, beginning at 11am. This could offer an excellent opportunity for even a small number of trained volunteers to develop their own skills providing a crucial local service, while growing awareness of a welcoming Church for those struggling on the margins.
